Donation Guidelines

Appliances: 7 years or newer (**dishwashers not accepted**)

Cabinets & Countertops: solid wood fronts with all drawers & doors

Doors: except shower & hollow core w/o jam

Hardware: all types & fasteners

Flooring: carpet: unused, 100 sq. ft min.

Furniture: no rips, stains, smells or broken parts

Linoleum: unused, 25 sq. ft. min.; wood & laminate: unopened boxes

HVAC: furnaces, bathroom fans and vents

Lawn & Garden: tools, fencing, bricks and pavers

Lighting and Electrical: light fixtures, new electrical supplies

Lumber & Siding: 5 ft. or longer, no nails or screws

Paint: latex paint in undamaged, unopened, original containers w/ labels. No oil based or stains accepted

Sinks & Fixtures: clean, no chips, cracks or scratches

Roofing: asphalt, wood, metal, tar paper

Tile: quantities over 10 sq ft

Tools & Equip: in good working order, w/ all parts, pieces

Windows: vinyl or wood, undamaged, unfogged, in working order

Please Note: We are unable to accept tube TV's, mattresses, dishwashers and plumbing fixtures manufactured prior to January 2014

What is Habitat for Humanity?

Ulster County Habitat for Humanity is a locally-run affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International, a non-profit, faith-based housing organization. The ReStore will provide the funds for the building of family homes on an ongoing basis. The generosity of our neighbors' donations and enthusiastic support of our volunteers makes this all possible. Volunteers assist with retail sales, repairs, refurbishing furniture, warehousing, donation pick-ups, marketing, and volunteer recruitment.

How Does Habitat for Humanity Work in Ulster County? The Ulster County affiliate of Habitat for Humanity connects qualified families in need of decent housing with volunteers and community businesses to build simple, affordable homes. Partner families invest themselves in the program by putting in 300 "sweat equity" hours to the organization. The families then purchase their home through a low or no interest, no profit mortgage.

What Happens to the Items I Donate?

Donations are the core of a successful ReStore. Homeowners, storeowners, contractors and factories provide the necessary donated materials to keep the ReStore fully stocked. The ReStore accepts donations of home goods, appliances and building materials, providing an environmentally and socially responsible way to keep good, reusable materials out of landfills. Items donated are sold through Habitat's ReStore and the money is used to build houses with approved Habitat partner families. Profits from the ReStore will help Ulster County Habitat for Humanity build more affordable and safe housing for, and in partnership with, low-income working families.

What Types of Items Are Needed?

How Can I Become Involved?

Ulster County Habitat for Humanity has extensive opportunities for volunteers, many of which do not require construction skills or a large commitment of time.
